- Total budget: € 2.6 million (TV-series: € 2.2 million / web format: € 0.4 million)
- First project in 20 years uniting all ARTE-branches: ARTE G.E.I.E., ARTE France, ARTE Deutschland
- 70 shooting days in 11 countries
- More than 70 interviewees for TV-series, 30 interviewees for web format
- Interviews in 13 languages
- 5 Eastern European co-producers: Eureka Media (PL), Havas Films (HU), HiFilm (RO), Trigon Production (SK), Hyper Market Film (CZ)
- 7 Eastern European broadcasters: TVP, MTV, TVR, Czech TV, Slovak TV, LRT, ERR
- Eastern European creative team: Andrei Nekrasov, director TV-series (RU), György Dalos, author book (HU), dense network of researchers in 10 Eastern European countries
- Access to 33 public archives in East and West, over 360 hours of archive material
